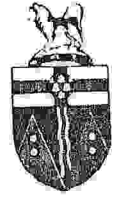

This is the Yukon Gold Panners Net originating out of Whitehorse Yukon in Northwest Canada.

This net meets each Sunday at 1100 hrs. local time 1900 hrs.Z on the frequency of 28.785 MHz.

The Yukon Gold Panners is a Chapter of the Ten - Ten International and the purpose of the net is to pass information and to create friends and interests in the Yukon and on Ten Meters.

At this time I will ask those on frequency to please stand by so that we can find out how many of our V.I.P.s and Charters are on frequency in order to assist those wishing to qualify for our basic certificate or collect additional points for our S.S.Klondike Award.

This is VY1AU - the name is Bill and I am your net control this morning.

The QTH is Whitehorse, Yukon and my 10X - 20659.
I am V.I.P.#1 with an S.S.KLONDIKE of #1 for a total of 12 points.

Qualifications for the Basic certificate is 25 points which must include 1 VIP contact plus \$1.00.

Qualifications for the S.S.Klondike is 100 points plus \$1.00 and can include the initial points attained for the basic certificate.

V.I.P.s are worth 10 points.

Charters and Honorary Charters are worth 5 Points.

First State, First Province and First Country are worth 3 points and all others are worth 1 point.

Members with the Basic certificate plus the S.S.Klondike are worth an additional 2 points.

YUKON SOURDOUGH AWARD

The Yukon Gold Panners will be issuing a new certificate called the "Yukon Sourdough Award".

This award will be available commencing Sunday, April 29, 1979 at 1900Z and all qualifying contacts must be made April 29th and after.

Certificate Requirements:

- 20 contacts which must include:
- 15 Different Continental U/S States
- 2 Yukon Territory Contacts
- 2 Dx Country Contacts (Hawaii will count as Dx)
- 1 Canadian Province Contact

All contacts must be on ten meters with holders of the Yukon Gold Panners Certificate and applicants must hold the Yukon Gold Panners Award plus the S.S. Klondike Award.

Cost of the certificate will be:

\$1 plus 2 x 15¢ stamps or 8 IRCs

The Yukon Sourdough Award will be worth an additional 10 points.

There will be single qualifier numbers awarded and will be designated by the letter "Q". These will be limited to 1 per State, Province or Country and contact with holders of these numbers will qualify stations for the Basic Yukon Gold Panners Certificate and will be worth a total of 25 points.

New applicants can submit for all 3 awards at the same time providing all of the qualifications are met, for each award (cost for this type of submission \$3.00 + 2 x 15¢ stamps or 20 IRCs).
